

Amber Boardman's paintings examine the influence of the internet on ever changing social norms and crowd behaviour. These narrative paintings draw from the visual language of cartoons—bold colours, simplified shapes—which was influenced in part by her work as an animator for Cartoon Network's [adult swim], Comedy Central and Google.

Boardman holds a PhD from the University of New South Wales in Sydney, and an MFA from the School of Visual Arts in New York. She has exhibited paintings and public art installations internationally since 2002. Notable exhibitions include the Archibald and Geelong Prizes in Australia, BAM's Next Wave Festival in New York City, and an exhibition with Postmasters Gallery in Rome in 2018. The artist has been the recipient of multiple awards, notably the Most Provocative Award (Atlanta Biennial), the Australian Post-Graduate Award (University of New South Wales) and the Joan Sutherland Fund Visual Arts Grant.


Her works are held in major collections including Artbank and The City of Sydney in Australia, and the High Museum of Art, The Museum of Contemporary Art of Georgia, the University of Kentucky Art Museum in America. Boardman's work has also appeared in publications including *Artist Profile*, *Art Collector*, *Juxtapoz*, and *ArtMaze Magazine*.














